Synopsis

It is Paris by night. The nightclub of the moment is "L'OEUF", but this particular evening, the charming owner, Albert Simoni, is missing. His body is found in an out of the way corner of the Bois de Boulogne.

The investigation is placed in the hands of Inspector Vallois, (Jean Gabin), of the International section. From Marquis, (Robert Berri), the dead man's colleague, he learns little, except that Simoni had had a very beautiful German mistress, named Lucky, (Nadja Tiller). With the possibility that she may have killed her lover, in mind, Vallois goes to her, and almost in spite of himself, is drawn to her, and finds himself pitying the lost and unhappy creature he sometimes glimpses within her.

But, although there is only one killer, several people are involved. Vallois, makes his decision, and without neglecting his duty, sees to it that the guilty one will be punished without involving the innocent, or relatively innocent people around the murder. And to make sure of her safety, he takes Lucky with him, out of the sinister house which holds the secret of a sudden and violent death.
